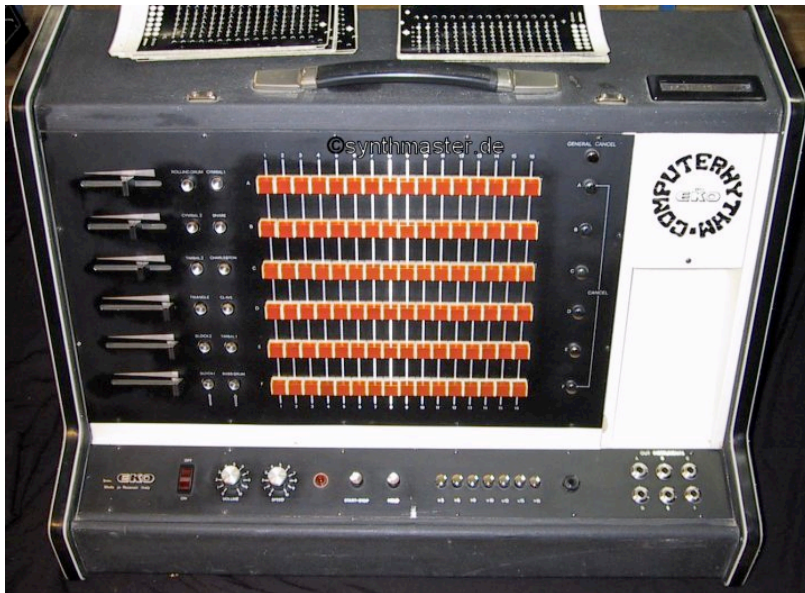


EKO COMPUTHERM



Only 15 to 25 are made by EKO in Italy . Used on Oxygene and Equinoxe from Jean Michel Jarre.

The heart of the EKO is not a computer (like the name tells) , but a TTL generator based on 74154 (1to16 decoder) ,7493 (binary counter) and a clock generator. He has 12 instruments , rolling-drum + cymbal 1 , cymbal 2 + snare ,timbal 2 + charleston ,triangle + clave ,block 2 + timbal 1 ,block 1 + bassdrum . By pressing one ore more from the 16 x 6 pushbuttons they begins to illuminate and the instrument is programmed (like the 808) Two instruments have one slider for volume and the instruments are switchable as a single sound or both sounds together .The pusbutons on the right side are for canceling all traks together or for on trak . With the punchcard reader on the right side you can programm with punch cards a precast rhythm.
